#### Title of the Practice: "A Visit to Jivandhara Vidyalaya"

#### **Objective of the Practice:**

- Providing love and affection to the **specially abled** students.
- To integrate the specially abled children with normal children.

**The Context:** This activity has been conducting since last five years, Due to Covid-19 pandemic academic year 2019-20 and 2020-21, the students were totally depended on online media, but since many of them were not having mobile and some parents were not able to use the online media. Still we saw that efforts were taken by the school authorities to educate them. Also since the students were not avaible in offline the activity was conducted in offline mode. The Children were very interactive and happy.

The Practice: A visit to Jivandhara Vidyalaya is organized every year. As part of this three to four faculty members and few students (nearly about 20) visit the school. We also provided the necessary teaching aids and stationery like Craft materials ,charts,toys etc. The College students also interact with the special able students ,and play games with them. The interaction during the event helps our students to build relationships and understand different perspectives. We got to know that these children required skill teachers to teach them and also the difficulties teachers face while training them.
